IN ADDITION, HCZ COMMITTED TO PROVIDE THE SCHOOL WITH THE USE OF SPACE IN ITS PREMISES LOCATED AT 35 EAST 125TH STREET, NEW YORK, NY. THE AMOUNT REPORTED FOR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2013 TOTALS \$4,871,205. INCLUDED WITHIN THE \$4,871,205 OF GIFTS-IN-KIND IS DONATED FOOD OF \$725,739. THE DONATED FOOD IS REPORTED ON PART VIII, LINE 1(G) AND ON SCHEDULE M.

HCZ MAINTAINS A 457(F) PLAN FOR CERTAIN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL. EMPLOYEES BECOME ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PLAN BASED SOLELY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SCHOOL'S BOARD OF TRUSTEES. THE AMOUNTS CONTRIBUTED VEST FIVE YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF THE INITIAL CONTRIBUTION AND WILL THEN BE PAID TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES WHEN VESTED. HCZ PROVIDES THE SCHOOL WITH AN ANNUAL SUBSIDY TO COVER THIS COST BY CONTRIBUTING TO A HCZ INVESTMENT ACCOUNT. DURING FISCAL 2012, HCZ PROVIDED A SUBSIDY OF \$1,303,500 FOR THE FISCAL 2012 CONTRIBUTION TO THE 457(F) PLAN.
