Acceptance of Minutes (Geoffrey Canada)

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. and a motion was called to approve the meeting minutes from October 30, 2019. The motion was unanimously approved.

Superintendent's Update (Dr. Achil Petit)

Dr. Achil Petit reported that enrollment is at 1,135 for Promise Academy I and at 1,036 for Promise Academy II.

Dr. Petit also reported that 20 Promise Academy teachers attended the annual gala for Determined to Educate (DTE). As a partner of HCZ and Promise Academy, DTE invites professionals to visit HCZ staff and scholars for inspirational talks on career and life choices. The teachers were acknowledged at the event for their contributions to education.

HCZ Promise Academy II Elementary School (Dr. Shondell James)

The elementary school's attendance was at 94% for October.

In celebration of Halloween, the school held a Book-a-Ween event for grades K-5. Students and staff dressed up for the day as a character from their favorite book. Grades 3-5 also went trick or treating at PAII Middle School. Senior staff members dressed in costume and visited school sites as part of the annual "Character Express."

Students are engaging in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) in new and exciting ways. Fourth and fifth-grade students are involved in "Makerspace," a science class that teaches students how to create objects in a collaborative workspace using recyclable materials. In third grade, students are building sailboats and learning about states of matter.

In social studies, students are working on Google Slide presentations about continents and connecting with people from different cultures.

Students are preparing to perform in the play "The Paper Bag Princess" and for a December winter concert.

HCZ Promise Academy II Middle School (Amy Deal)

The middle school's attendance was at 96% for October.

Seventh graders went on an overnight trip to the Fresh Air Fund's Sharpe Reservation. Students enjoyed team-building activities and nature walks. Sixth-grade students visited the Wolf Conservation Center.

Cornell scientists visited the middle school and guided the scholars in science experiments with electrons.

Staff celebrated Unity Day by participating in a potluck and wearing matching shirts.

HCZ Promise Academy II High School (Kashif Hameed)

The high school's attendance was at 96% for October. Staff members will continue to be intentional about keeping attendance rates high.

The high school held student government elections. The new class president met with the principal to discuss encouraging student attendance and other student initiatives.

Students and staff relaxed on the day before Thanksgiving break with basketball, dodgeball, tugof-war and painting.

High school students are preparing for their Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) on December 7th.

In the spring, New York Times reporter, Robin Pogrebin, will be volunteering her services to help high school students with their college personal statements.

PAII Financial Report (Jim Hutter)

PAII's enrollment is at 1,036, which is eight students favorable. PAII revenue is \$100,000 unfavorable versus budget. PAII is also on \$100,000 favorable with expenses at \$6.1M. There is no HCZ contribution through the first four months of FY20.

Student Presentation (Dr. Achil Petit)

Promise Academy students who perform as part of the Forces of Nature dance company had the opportunity to travel to South Africa and perform in a competition at the Soweto theater in Johannesburg. Forces of Nature Artistic Director Abdel Salaam and two of the scholars spoke about the trip and expressed how humbled they were by the experience. The scholars were grateful for the opportunity.
