### Acceptance of Minutes (Geoffrey Canada)

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m., and a motion was called to approve the meeting minutes from November 26, 2019. The motion was unanimously approved.

### **CEO Report (Anne Williams-Isom)**

Anne Williams-Isom reported that HCZ's annual gift-wrapping event was held on December 9, 2019. The event was a success with over 100 volunteers visiting HCZ to wrap more than 4,000 toys for the children in HCZ programs.

Ms. Williams-Isom also reported that Superintendent Dr. Achil Petit and Deputy of Special Projects Susan Rydz joined her in a visit to a Success Academy middle school in Harlem to share best practices.

Chief Operating Officer Kwame Owusu-Kesse introduced the new managing director of the development department, Liam McCarthy, who will be leading HCZ's institutional and individual giving functions. Promise Academy board members welcomed Mr. McCarthy to his new role.

Geoffrey Canada, Ms. Williams-Isom and Mr. Owusu-Kesse met with teachers and staff at Promise schools to show appreciation for their hard work and dedication.

### Superintendent's Update (Dr. Achil Petit)

Dr. Achil Petit reported that enrollment is at 1,130 for Promise Academy I and at 1,032 for Promise Academy II.

Dr. Petit thanked the development department for organizing a book donation from Simon & Schuster. Early childhood programs and Promise Academy schools received over 18,000 books for scholars and families.

Dr. Petit also thanked Mr. Owusu-Kesse and Jessica Lake, Managing Director of Social Services, for allowing the social work team to present suicide prevention at the monthly Principal's Pipeline Meeting.

### HCZ Promise Academy II Elementary School (Dr. Shondell James)

The elementary school's attendance was at 93% for November. The school is working hard to increase attendance.

The school held a dean's list assembly for third and fourth graders who scored 80% or above. Also, an "honor roll breakfast" was held for 50 fifth-grade students.

The school staff members distributed turkeys to families in November and held a potluck for school staff and families.

The week before the break was Spirit Week.

### **HCZ Promise Academy II Middle School (Amy Deal)**

The middle school's attendance was at 96% for November.

The student drama club went on a trip to see an off-Broadway performance of "Alice in Wonderland." The nature club visited an organic farm. The Deuce News club produced their first school newspaper, and the arts and meditation club created a set of wings to represent uplifting the school spirit.

The chess teams won tournaments in three different categories over the past weekend.

Students in The Working Group on Girls club, a strong network established with the United Nations, began activities for this school year by meeting with an United Nations Minister of Foreign Affairs.

### HCZ Promise Academy II High School (Kashif Hameed)

The high school's attendance was at 96% for November.

The Snowball Semi-Formal Dance was held for the school's seniors and included a live band.

The basketball team is preparing for their varsity season with tryout sessions.

The school held its second half-day of professional development for teachers and staff.

A *New York Times* reporter helped students work on personal statements for college applications during a professional development and writing workshop.

Staff leaders showed appreciation and celebrated the holidays with a team breakfast and lunch. The administrative team will also have a holiday celebration.

High school students from both PAI and PAII will go on a snow-tubing trip on December 20, 2019.

### Financial Report (Jim Hutter)

PAII's enrollment is at 1,032, which is four students favorable. PAI revenue is \$100,000 unfavorable versus the budget. PAII is on \$100,000 favorable with expenses at \$8.2M. There is no HCZ contribution through five months of FY20.
