Harlem Children's Zone (HCZ) Promise Academy I Charter School Board Meeting Wednesday, February 15, 2023 Video Conference

Acceptance of Minutes (Geoffrey Canada)

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 AM, and a motion to approve the meeting minutes from January 18, 2023, was unanimously approved.

CEO Report (Kwame Owusu-Kesse)

Chief Executive Officer Kwame Owusu-Kesse reported that HCZ Promise Academy graduating scholars are scheduled to be photographed with leadership on February 15 at the Apollo Theater.

Mr. Owusu-Kesse also reported that he visited ELLevation, a mission-driven company dedicated to supporting English Language Learners. Mr. Owusu-Kesse spoke to 200 ELLevation employees in Arizona about innovative practices and culture-building.

Mr. Owusu-Kesse met with 100 HCZ Promise Academy High School juniors and seniors to discuss economic mobility as part of HCZ's Wealth Builds initiative.

Superintendent's Update (Dr. Achil Petit)

Superintendent Dr. Achil Petit reported that enrollment is 1,122 for HCZ Promise Academy I and 988 for HCZ Promise Academy II.

Dr. Petit visited Harlem Gems on January 24 and February 14 to read to scholars.

Dr. Petit and Deputy Superintendent Dr. Saskia Brown will host a luncheon for staff members who have perfect attendance to thank them for their dedication.

HCZ Promise Academy I Elementary School (Dr. Joseph Cordero)

Principal Dr. Joseph Cordero reported the Elementary School's attendance was 95% for January.

The Elementary School held parent/teacher conferences with 345 parents attending.

Elementary School leaders continue to meet with the HCZ Promise Academy I Parent Association (PAPA I) Board of Trustees.

Dr. Cordero's Just a Moment sessions have been well attended by parents who have questions about school operations and their scholar's progress.

The Elementary School held a winter showcase of K-5 scholar artwork.

The Elementary School held an Honor Roll Dinner for top-performing scholars, with over 300 guests attending.

Elementary School leaders held meetings to strategize enrollment efforts for the 2023-2024 school year.

The Elementary School continued to partner with the Spence School for Girls, completing a round of Code Camp for third-grade scholars. Additionally, Teresa Ridgeway, a programmer at Google and the author of *Think Like a Computer*, visited, read to scholars, and taught them how to debug a computer. Fourth-grade scholars begin Code Camp in April.

HCZ Promise Academy I Middle School (Madelaine German-Schultz)

Principal Madelaine German-Schultz reported that the Middle School's attendance was 94% for January.

To strengthen outreach efforts, school leaders invited parents of middle school-age scholars on the HCZ Promise Academy waitlist to visit and tour the school. Parents asked questions about operations and scholars' learning.

The Middle School held a dance to celebrate scholars who have had fewer than two behavior infractions and fewer than three tardies during the past 45 days.

The Middle School boys group met to engage in team-building activities and discuss their goals and the barriers to achieving them. The Middle School's deans and operations director facilitated the event.

Saturday Academy continues to be successful, with as many as 117 scholars attending to receive academic support.

HCZ Promise Academy I High School (Amy Deal)

Principal Amy Deal reported that the High School's attendance was 94% for January.

The High School hosted a professional development session for staff members focusing on the theme of "keeping small things small." The workshop was designed to teach staff members how to better manage interactions with scholars and set intentions.

In January, the High School's student government hosted a pep rally and gave out awards to teachers and scholars. Scholars in the student government group also supported HCZ Promise Academy I Elementary School's award ceremony by decorating the space and handing out awards.

Principal Deal thanked Operations Director Jenny Arias for coordinating the photography sessions at the Apollo Theater for graduating seniors.

The High School hosted a senior breakfast with Dr. Petit.

Scholars from both HCZ Promise Academy high schools will compete in a basketball game on February 16 at the 245 West 129th Street gymnasium.

Financial Update (Connor Fournier)

CFO, Connor Fournier, reported that Promise Academy I's enrollment is 1,122, which is ten unfavorable versus the budget. The school's revenue is \$0.1M unfavorable at \$13.2M. Expenses are \$0.6M favorable at \$11.9M. HCZ has not made a contribution through seven months of FY23.
